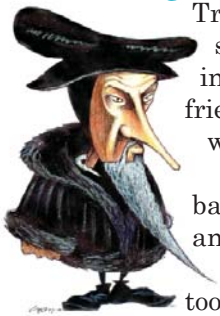

Meal bagging for North Texas Food Bank

We will gather together as a church family, along with members of the organization Meals of Hope, for a three hour meal packing event on Sunday, August 21, assembling meals that will go to the North Dallas Food Bank for local distribution.

What You Need to Know:

- We will be bagging 120,000 meals for others to eat.
- We will need at least 600 volunteers to complete this task.
- We will have two opportunities to serve: the first before Worship from 8:15 - 9:45 a.m. and the second following Worship from 11:15 a.m. to 12:45 p.m., both in Jubilee Hall.
